GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

All registered participants are invited to submit abstracts for POSTER PRESENTATION

Abstracts must be submitted to: posteriadt2010@sidtraumidentali.com

On or before February 28, 2010.

Abstracts received after this date will not be accepted.

Accepted abstracts will be published in Dental Traumatology.

Abstract submission will be acknowledged electronically.

All abstracts must be submitted in English. Author(s) must ensure that the abstract adheres in style and format to the abstract submission guidelines outlined below.

Abstracts that do not comply with the guidelines will not be accepted.

The abstract must be of original work that has not already been published or is being considered for publication elsewhere. The submitted abstract will be deemed to have been signed by all authors listed in the submission and authors will be responsible for all statements made in their work.

Acceptance of an abstract and assignment to a session will be determined solely by IADT Congress Committee based on a review of its scientific content.

Acceptance of abstracts will be transmitted on or before March 31, 2010.

STYLE and FORMAT

TITLE

(Use a short and concise title that clearly reflects the nature of the study/procedure)

The title should be typed in title case and should not exceed 200 characters including spaces.

Abbreviation should not be used in the title.

Author name(s): Names of each author must be listed in this order - First name, Middle name, and Surname (with initials of the first and middle name). Underline the name of the presenting author. A maximum of six authors may be included.

Affiliation: Complete affiliation (name of the department[s] and institution[s]) and full contact details (postal address, telephone, fax numbers and email address) of the presenting author must be included.
